2016 General Election Ballot & Instructions

- Member must be in good standing (all assessments paid.)
- Each lot owner is allowed one vote for each board vacancy per lot owned. You have 4 votes if you own one lot. There are only a few members who own two lots and only they are allowed 8. Your votes can be distributed among the candidates as you desire. (Example: One vote for each candidate; all to one candidate; or any other split with the maximum number based on the number of lots you own as per above.)
- Do not sign the ballot unless you are using the proxy statement. The proxy is to be used ONLY when you assign someone to vote for you.
- If you don't know who to vote for or don't want to vote, check "None of Above", but return the ballot envelope in order that a quorum be reached, or give proxy to someone else to vote for you.
- Place the ballot in the ballot envelope. Don't forget to **sign and date the envelope**.
- Your name MUST remain on the ballot envelope to verify eligibility or it won't be counted. Your vote will remain anonymous.
- SIGN AND RETURN THE BALLOT ENVELOPE! Give it to a board member, mail it to SLPPOA at the above address, or bring it to the meeting on September 10, 2016, at 2:00 p.m.
- Ballots may be completed at the meeting since nominations can be made from the floor.
- A quorum of eligible <u>ballots</u> needs to be returned by the membership (1/3 of the total membership in good standing). Please do your part by returning the ballots so we can ensure a valid election.
- Ballots are due by election time September 10, 2016.
