ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned, all being of full age, certify that we have on this date formed a corporation under the laws of the State of New Mexico, and we do further certify.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be SIERRA LOS PINOS PROPERTY OWNERS ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes are to provide services to members of the Association within Sierra Los Pinos Subdivision in Sandoval County, New Mexico, such services to include the promotion of members' privacy, recreation, health, safety and welfare, the promotion of environmental protection for Sierra Los Pinos Subdivision, the administration of architectural review and control of improvements within Sierra Los Pinos Subdivision, provision of maintenance, repair, improvement and supervision for members' commonly owned property within Sierra Los Pinos Subdivision and acquisition, construction, repair and maintenance of a water system or systems for the benefit of members of the Association. The Association shall fix, levy and collect all charges and assessments owed by members and others to the Association and shall pay all expenses incurred in conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the Association or its property. The Association may acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the business of the Association. The Association may engage in all other activity permitted by law and in accordance with the by-laws of the Association.
